On Dec. 27 he consented to an operation on his father and brother, and Eli went to be with him. After the operation he came out of the ether alright, and had a long chat with Eli. After this chat he quietly passed away. Poor health had lasted about 3 years. After being discharged from the service, he entered Washington University of Dentistry, but on account of his health, he had to give up his school work. He made Master Mason at the age of 21 in the Kinmundy Lodge.
